CHANGES MADE BY THIS TARIFF

- 1) Weekly and Monthly TransPasses on Regional Rail will be valid only for airport trips and travel between Center City Zone Stations on non-holiday weekdays. They will retain “Anywhere” privilege on weekends and holidays.
- 2) The cost of the Convenience Pass has been increased to SEVEN DOLLARS (\$7.00).
- 3) The Special Event One Day pass has been replaced by the Independence Passes.
- 4) Quantity purchase prices have been increased.

(A) REGIONAL RAIL DIVISION/TRANSIT DIVISION JOINT FARE

- 1) A valid Monthly or Weekly TrailPass entitles a passenger to a one-way trip in either direction involving no more than the Fare Zone(s) up to the limits of the zone shown on the face of the pass, on any regularly scheduled transit route service vehicle operated by either City Transit Division or Suburban Transit Division during the calendar month or week for which issued and until 2:00 A.M. of the day following the last day of the month or week.

The TrailPass also entitles the passenger to all transit privileges accorded passengers using a City Transit Division TransPass. Additional zone charges, rules and regulations, are governed by City Transit Division General Rate Tariff No. 1 and Suburban Transit Division General Rate Tariff No. 155.

- 2) A valid Monthly or Weekly TransPass entitles a passenger to unrestricted travel on any regularly scheduled Regional Rail train at all times between stations designated as Center City Philadelphia in Tariff No. 154.

- a) For a non-holiday weekday trip beyond stations designated as Center City Philadelphia, the regular fare, from origin to destination, applies.
- b) Trips made under this provision may not be extended or stepped-up.
- c) Privilege valid for travel for trips between Center City Philadelphia (CCP) stations and the Airport at all times.

- 3) A valid Monthly or Weekly TransPass entitles a passenger to an unlimited number of trips in either direction for a one zone ride on any regularly scheduled SEPTA transit (bus, trolley, subway-elevated) route service vehicle for the duration of the pass and until 2:00 AM on the day following the last day of the valid week or month.

- 4) A Cross County Pass is valid during the calendar month for which it was issued and until 2:00 A.M. of the day following the last day of the month, for unlimited travel in any direction involving any number of Fare Zones on any regularly scheduled Regional Rail train at any time within suburban counties only. For travel to, from or via Center City Philadelphia on a non-holiday weekday, Zone 1 fares will apply in addition to the pass. Additional privileges, rules and regulations are governed by Regional Rail Division General Rate Tariff No. 154. The Cross County Pass is sold for the personal use of the passenger whose signature appears on the pass.

- 5) A valid Monthly or Weekly TransPass, Cross-County Pass or TrailPass has "Anywhere" status on weekends and holidays and is valid for unlimited travel in

any direction on any regularly scheduled SEPTA route service vehicle without payment of additional fares or zone charges. Holidays are defined in the current supplements of the applicable operating Tariffs Nos. 1, 154, and 155.

(B) CITY TRANSIT DIVISION/SUBURBAN TRANSIT DIVISION JOINT FARES

- 1) A cash fare or a token (subject to time and directional control) is valid for a one-way trip, in either direction, involving no more than one fare zone. Charges, rules and regulations for travel within the City Transit Division are governed by the City Transit Division General Rate Tariff No. 1. Additional zone fare charges, rules and regulations for travel within the Suburban Transit Division are governed by the Suburban Transit Division General Rate Tariff No. 155.
- 2) The Weekly or Monthly TransPass will be accepted as payment for any one zone fare on any one way trip operated by the Suburban Transit Division. Additional zone fares beyond the first zone traveled continue to apply. Additional zone fare charges within the City Transit Division are governed by the City Transit Division General Rate Tariff No. 1. Additional zone fare charges within the Suburban Transit Division are governed by the Suburban Transit Division General Rate Tariff No. 155. TransPasses are sold for the personal use of the passenger whose signature appears on the back of the pass.
- 3) A Cross County Pass is valid during the calendar month for which it was issued and until 2:00 A.M. of the day following the last day of the month, for unlimited travel in any direction involving any number of Fare Zones on any regularly scheduled transit route service vehicle operated by either the City Transit or Suburban Transit Division within suburban counties only. Additional privileges, rules and regulations are governed by Suburban Transit Division General Rate Tariff No. 155. The Cross County Pass is sold for the personal use of the passenger whose signature appears on the pass.
- 4) A valid Cross County Pass plus an additional zone fare entitles a passenger to a one-way trip, in either direction, on any route within the City of Philadelphia. Additional zone fare charges within the City Transit Division are governed by the City Transit Division General Rate Tariff No. 1.

(C) CONVENIENCE PASS

A CONVENIENCE PASS is valid for a single day's travel of up to eight (8) one-way trips in either direction on any scheduled transit (bus, trolley, subway-elevated train) route. The CONVENIENCE PASS is available for Seven Dollars (\$7.00). It will be valid during the calendar day designated by the date punched at the time of the first use and until 2:00 AM of the following day. At the discretion of the General Manager, use of this pass may be prohibited during AM peak hours on non-holiday weekdays.

(D) INDIVIDUAL INDEPENDENCE PASS

An INDIVIDUAL INDEPENDENCE PASS is valid for a single day's travel for one individual for unlimited trips in either direction on any scheduled transit (bus, trolley, sub-elevated train) route or on any Regional Rail train scheduled to arrive in Center City stations after 9:30 AM on weekdays and on all Regional Rail trains on Saturday, Sunday and holidays. The INDIVIDUAL INDEPENDENCE PASS is available for Eleven Dollars (\$11.00). It will be valid during the calendar day shown on pass until 2:00 AM of the following day. An additional \$5.00 surcharge will be applied for travel on each Regional Rail trip to or from the State of New Jersey

(E) FAMILY INDEPENDENCE PASS

A FAMILY INDEPENDENCE PASS is valid for a single day's travel for five individuals where at least one and not more than two is at least eighteen years of age for unlimited trips in either direction on any scheduled transit (bus, trolley, sub-elevated train) route or on any Regional Rail train scheduled to arrive in Center City stations after 9:30 AM on weekdays and on all Regional Rail trains on Saturday, Sunday and holidays. The FAMILY INDEPENDENCE PASS will be available for Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$28.00). It will be valid during the calendar day shown on pass until 2:00 AM of the following day. An additional \$15.00 surcharge will be applied for travel on each Regional Rail trip to or from the State of New Jersey

(F) QUANTITY PURCHASES

- 1) Monthly and Weekly Passes may be sold in quantity to qualifying employers or organizations at incentive prices per the following schedule. To qualify for incentive prices, which are approximately 95% of the regular single purchase price, employers or organizations must be registered with SEPTA as a participating employer or organization.
 - a) Orders for all passes must be placed with SEPTA well in advance of start of the week or month for which passes are valid. (Cut-off date to be determined by SEPTA.)
 - b) Payment for all passes must be made to SEPTA by employer or organization in advance of receipt of passes by employer or organization.
 - c) Minimum order for Monthly passes is fifty (50) passes per month. The minimum order for Weekly passes is fifty (50) passes per week.
 - d) In order to participate in the Corporate Pass Program (COMPASS) the organization must, at minimum, match the 5% discount offered by SEPTA to its employees or members. A greater discount may be provided by qualifying employees or organizations, without limitation.

- 2) Cost to employers or organizations participating in the Quantity Purchase Price Program will be as follows:

- 3) Elementary and secondary schools (Grades K-12) and school districts may participate in the program for the purchase of tokens to be used by school students for educational travel purposes.
- a) The minimum purchase to qualify for the discount is 100 ten-packs (1,000 tokens).
 - b) Orders and payment must be made to SEPTA in advance of receipt of tokens by school or school district.
 - c) SEPTA will offer a 5% discount for student token orders provided the school or school district offers a minimum 5% additional discount to students through direct subsidy.

- 4) Participating employers or organizations may provide passes to their employees or organization members at a price which is equal to or less than the Quantity Incentive Price indicated on the schedule above.
- 5) Convenience Passes and Independence Passes will be available at a quantity purchase price. Conditions and rates will be established by the SEPTA Sales Department and may be revised from time to time. The quantity discount may not exceed twenty percent (20%) of the regular single purchase price.
- 6) SEPTA reserves the right to enter into agreements with organizations regarding quantity sale of other pre-purchased fare instruments according to the regulations set forth above.
